The purpose of this Annual Program Statement (APS) is to solicit applications for funding. DAI Global LLC, under contract to the United States Agency for International Development (USAID), is seeking concept papers from prospective partners to implement activities that create new, or support existing sustainable water and/or sanitation services and/or products. These activities will contribute to the strengthening of the water and sanitation service sector in the urban or peri-urban areas of: Cap-Haitien, Mirebalais, Croix-des-Bouquets (Canaan), Les Cayes et Jeremie. Applications must target services or products in the above communes.

DAI anticipates awarding several grants, of various sizes and durations, in response to this APS. Competition for this APS will be open for one year. All concept papers for review in the first round of evaluations are due by **August 31, 2018**. At the discretion of DAI, applications received after the first round of evaluations may be considered as part of another round of evaluations. All interested eligible entities will be equally considered.

The length of the programs proposed may be one (1) year. DAI may choose to fully fund or incrementally fund the selected application(s). The number of awards and amount of available funding is subject to change and DAI reserves the right to make no awards as a result of this APS. Applicants may choose to propose a range of initiatives, pilots, or scale up small projects that already have demonstrated success. Awardees will be expected to share evaluation results and key lessons, and disseminate periodic activities and outcomes.

DAI is seeking partners with creative, innovative, and effective approaches, that may address the relationship between private and public sector, focus intensely on direct beneficiary results, and have the potential to scale up and be sustainable and maintainable.



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DAI will work collaboratively with potential partners on accelerating their business and building capacity at the same time. Applicants must demonstrate success in managing cultural and political considerations in the proposed focus country or region as well as success in addressing DAI's development and contractual objectives.
